

USE AND CARE OF REFINISHED SURFACES

- Clean refinished surfaces regularly to avoid buildup.
- Only clean with mild cleaners that state “OK to use on refinished surfaces,” and rinse thoroughly
- Do not use bleach, mild acids, abrasive scrubs, soft scrubs, liquid comet, Bon Ami, etc.
- Always rinse cleansers off completely.
- For stubborn stains or scum buildup, use a Purex Dobie pad or a nylon net scrubber. Let the non-abrasive cleaner stand on the surface for 1-2 minutes. Do not use Scotch-Brite pads or other heavy abrasion type pads.
- Fix your leaky faucets. Dripping water will wear through the hardest of surfaces. Make sure your plumbing problems are fix immediately.
- Do not store soap, plastic or metal bottles or other products in corners of tubs, showers, or sinks.
- Use a non-suction type bathmat. The suction bathmats will harm your finish.
- You should not leave any bathmats on the tub from day to day. If you use a bathmat, take it out of the tub when finished bathing.
- Be careful with use of any other items or products that main stain the surface coat, i.e. ink, make-up, lotions, etc.
- Do not rest hot items directly on refinished surfaces.
